## Inspire Me!

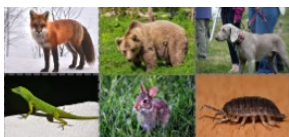
## RE 2

Pupils will learn about the environment and how we can do more to look after it and our whole planet.



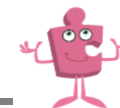
## DT
