This term our reading focus will be:

- A range of decodable texts.

During story time and reading for pleas pils will be exposed to a range of stories, nonfiction texts and poetry.

How to help your child with their reading at home:

- Read your child's reading book daily.
- Discuss the reading book and ask questions that are in the back of the book.
- Practise the year 1 common exception words.

How to help your child with their writing at home:

- Practise letter formation
- Look at a picture, practise saying simple phrases or sentences that match.
- Practise writing the simple phrases or sentences using finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

How to help your child with their maths at home:

- Practise number formation
- Practise counting forwards and backwards to 20.
- Practise addition and subtraction within 10.
- Learn the names of 2D and 3D shapes.

Pupils will develop geographical knowledge and skills related to identifying homes in the locality and around the world.




DT
