Our Topic is - 'Kings and Queens'

In Science we are learning about plant growth. We will be looking at, naming and explaining the different parts of a plant. We will also investigate how plants grow and carry out an investigation to see in which conditions they grow best. We will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

In History we will be learning about the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements. We will be learning about the Monarch and researching different kings and queens. We will also compare aspects of life in different periods (for example, Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria).

In Art and Design we will be learning about light and dark shades to create self-portraits. We will be learning to shade using chalk and charcoal.

Literacy

This half term the children will be reading and writing a variety of genres, such as:

Fiction – Fantasy Stories Non-Fiction – Recounts Poetry – Humerous Poems

Children will continue to use and improve their skills in RWI.



During this half term the children will be focusing on the following topics –

- Number and place value beyond 100
- Doubling multiples
- Weight and capacity
- Fractions of a number
- Multiplication and division
- Doubling and halving
- Add and subtract using formal methods.
