

Stow Heath Primary School Year 6 Autumn Term 1st Half

Our Topic is - Black Out!

In History, we will be learning about World War Two and the role the Government played in protecting children. Children will learn what it was like to be an evacuee, the roles women played during the war and the effect it had on people's lives.

In Science we are studying light, we will be investigating shadows, how the eye works, how light travels and refraction.

In Art we are going to research war art. We will be looking at paper cutting and the skills of Wilhelm Gross. We will investigate colour which will allow us to create a Blitz war image.

Literacy

This half term the children will be reading and writing a variety of genres including non-chronological reports, stories and narrative poetry.

The children will be learning word class, homophones and homonyms, pronouns and verb tenses.

They will be exploring a historical, narrative poem. From this the children will write in a variety of styles.

Numeracy

Durin of term the children will be focusing on the following topics –

- Read, write and compare 6 digit numbers.
- Round whole numbers and decimals.
- Learn multiplication and division facts.
- Problem solving, reasoning and algebra.
- Measurement.
- Mental and written addition and subtraction
- Mental and written multiplication and division.
